- **Activation Process:** Online access is provided by user name and password. You will select your user name and password during the activation process.
- **Access to Back Issues:** A non-member online subscription includes access to current year plus all available back issues online. Upon cancellation, access will be provided for years subscribed.

### Institutions

- All prices are for a single site/location. See below for information on obtaining a multi-site quote.
- **Who Can Access the Journal:** An institutional online subscription allows unlimited simultaneous Internet access by authorized users at one geographical site (see below) and does not include remote campuses, consortia or other forms of subscription sharing. **If your institution has multiple sites, each site must purchase a separate subscription or the institution must purchase a multi-site subscription\*.**
- **Definition of an Authorized User:** Authorized users are defined as employees, faculty, staff, students and consultants, whether on a permanent, temporary or contract basis, who are officially associated with the subscribing site and are permitted to access the secure network. Patrons of the institution's library facilities are also considered authorized users.
- **Definition of a Site:** A site is defined as an organizational unit that may be academic or nonacademic and may consist of several buildings that are administered jointly. For organizations with facilities located in more than one city, each city office is considered a different site. For organizations within the same city that are administered independently, each office is considered a different site. For example, each campus in the State University of New York system is considered a different site, each branch or office of GlaxoSmithKline is considered a different site and each institute of the National Institutes of Health is considered a different site.
