On the cover, the figure demonstrates protease-substrate profiling of serine proteases thrombin and chymotrypsin. *Blue* fluorescence resulted from cleavage of the thrombin substrate, and the *red* and *green* fluorescence resulted from cleavage of the chymotrypsin substrates. Positions where no color was visible consisted of substrate-free spots. Epifluorescence microscopy revealed the dried aerosol between reaction centers and complete compartmentalization of each reaction center.
